

# Finishing touches

When it comes to customizing a frame for your photographs and prints, there are countless ways to make your artwork stand out. One way to add a finishing touch to the frame design is to include fillets.

Because of their classic appearance, fillets can help you create a timeless look. Whether your frame was designed 30 years ago or just last month, fillets can extend the life of the design so it doesn't seem outdated.

Fillets are most commonly used in mat openings, but that doesn't mean your options are limited. Turning fillet stock on its side can



create a space between the glass and backing of your frame. A reverse miter cut allows you to go around the outside edge of your art, creating a platform and hiding any imperfections, like tears, around the edges of your work.

If your artwork demands something more dramatic, we can repeat the fillet in the frame and the mat. Or for an over-the-top look, we can combine liners and fillets. With a wide range of colors, styles, and profile shapes, we can offer hundreds of options to achieve the style and design you want. ■
